



Lightroom Advanced Refresher - Importing and the Develop Module

Lightroom (LR) has gained rapid acceptance by millions of photographers because it provides the ultimate in organization, efficiency and improved image processing. This workshop will focus on two critical areas of the program – getting your images “into” LR and then optimizing your images using LR’s incredibly powerful Develop Module editing tools. This is a hands-on workshop. Participants bring a laptop computer (PC or Mac) with a current version of Lightroom (or Lightroom CC) and raw images so that you can practice what you learn.

This workshop is intended for current LR users who would like an in-depth refresher on image organization, importing and the Develop module and who feel that they are just not taking advantage of the full image editing capabilities of this software. They may be relatively comfortable with early versions of LR but not up-to-speed with the some of the nuances of enhancements in more recent versions. In addition, intermediate and more advanced Lightroom users have found this workshop valuable because of the many tips and tricks that they shared, as well as the help they receive in improving image evaluation skills that are so critical in optimizing image editing.

This is a small (maximum 6 people), hands-on workshop held at my studio in Bethesda, Maryland.
